

## Bible Changes. WHAT does Your Bible say???

History Shows that people used to try to copy to the exact same words as the original text or as close to that as they could. With today's translations copyright and ownership seem to be what's important. In order to get your own copyright you have to make enough changes that are different than any other book. Are you free to Read, and Quote, copy, print, and Share "GOD's Word" or does your bible belong to someone else?
